Reed Arts Creates Custom Storefront

Reed Arts in Columbus, OH, recently unveiled its new building facade—a giant gold frame that stands 15' tall and 18' wide. Company president Tim O'Neill decided the first part of his renovation project would command attention in traffic and also become a one-of-a-kind masterpiece to encourage custom framing.

National artist and Columbus resident Greg Ackers was commissioned to lay out, carve, paint, and install the frame, which is a reproduction of a seventeenth-century Spanish-style design.
